Thank you so much for being a part of the Evanston Scholars community and supporting this work.



Evanston Scholars provides a comprehensive, six-year program that guides students through the college admission process, supports them to persist through college graduation, and connects them to professional networks and strong job opportunities after college.

WHO WE SERVE

- Academically ambitious Evanston students with a minimum 2.7 unweighted GPA
- First-generation college entrants
- Students of color
- Students from families that earn low incomes

COLLEGE ACCESS

Scholars enter our College Access program in the summer before their junior year of high school. During their two years of college preparation they receive:

- A dedicated mentor to support them throughout the program
- One-on-one academic advising
- Monthly college preparation workshops
- College visits
- Test preparation
- Individualized college and financial aid counseling
- Resume and cover letter instruction
- Connections to summer jobs
- Counseling post-acceptance to determine their best academic and financial fit, which will make their goal of graduation much more attainable

JUSTIN ROYAL Freshman, Bradley University

When asked, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" Justin Royal has had the same answer since preschool: design video games. Justin kept this dream in mind in high school as he pursued challenging courses in computer programming, game

design, and web design which put him on the track to achieving his dream.

As a first-generation college student, Justin found the college search process daunting, but found being a part of Evanston Scholars made the process smooth. He says, "Having someone to talk things through with was very helpful. The Evanston Scholars community has a sense of warmth and support that is projected your way on every occasion. They want us to succeed." He plans to lean on this support system in college as well, saying "Knowing that you have a support system that's on the same plane as friends and family is important. I feel very prepared going into the college process."

Without a doubt, Jazmin Garcia is a high achiever. She graduated high school with a GPA well above a 4.0. As a college student at Washington University in St. Louis, she continued to excel academically and at the same time volunteer at a

local health clinic serving new immigrants and refugees.

Jazmin's parents had a clear vision for their daughter: for her to be the first one in their family to graduate from college. As a high school student, Jazmin was unsure of how to find a school that would fit her academic, financial, and social needs. She credits the mentorship and guidance from Evanston Scholars for helping her through that process and finding Wash U.

Looking back on her college years, Jazmin says, "Evanston Scholars was there for me through one-on-one meetings, check-ins, phone calls, emails, group meetings, you name it! This only scratches the surface of the opportunities I have received by being in Evanston Scholars and I cannot begin to go into detail about every single way I have received support, because I would go on forever."

Jazmin has set her sights on the next goal - becoming a physician. We know that Jazmin will *Make It Happen*, whatever she chooses to do!

connected with Publicis Sapient, an Evanston Scholars Career Readiness Partner, through a virtual internship during the summer of 2020. Upon her graduation in 2021, Naissa landed a full-time role. Throughout the process, she leaned on her support team. She says, "One of the most important things I learned is the importance of talking through decisions with your mentor, Evanston Scholars staff, and family members. The important people in your life know you best and are aware of your aspirations." Naissa utilized this network to practice mock interviews and evaluate job offers. She advises younger Scholars to follow in her footsteps, saying, "Looking for and eventually obtaining a good job cannot be done alone - you will need advice many times on how to navigate the job market."
